	MISTAKE	SOLUTION
1.	Ignoring red flags – for example ignoring a notice of land not for sale or land with an ongoing court case.	Avoid purchasing a property with an injunction, court case, a title deed with a caveat or a land clearly written not for sale
2.	Settling on a poor location – this affects appreciation and potential development.	Invest in a well researched location near amenities and developments for you to get value.
3.	Ignoring documentation and professionals	Always ensure you sign a sale agreement and title transfer form.
4.	Making emotional real estate decisions	Invest based on facts, trends and research
5.	Lack of clear investment plans	Always define your investment is it for building a home or for future investments
6.	Short term investment approach	Real estate is a long-term investment that appreciates over time and the potential for development as opposed to short term benefits

HIDDEN COSTS WHEN BUYING LAND THAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

When purchasing land, it is easy to focus on the purchase price and forget about other additional charges that may arise in the course of the transaction. Are you aware of some hidden costs when buying land that could cost you more? Below is a list of some hidden costs that you should be aware of. However, when you invest with Username you don't pay more because prices are inclusive with no hidden charges.

1. Stamp duty

This is the tax government places on legal documents, usually in the transfer of assets or property.

2.Legal fees

This is the fee paid for legal services during a land transaction.

3. Registration Fees

This is paid to the Lands Registry for purposes of making the entry into the registry and title printing costs.

4.Rates and Rent

This applies in leasehold properties and is payable to respective county governments where the land is situated.

5. Consents of transfer

This is an irrevocable written permission of the relevant Authority, Proprietor, Manager or any other interested person before any dealing with respect to a specific piece of land can be lawfully registered.

6. Valuation Costs

The cost of analysing a property to determine its market value.

7. Title deed search cost

The cost of retrieving documents showing events in the history of a piece of property to determine details and regulations concerning it.

8. The cost of value ads on the land

These includes the costs of grading roads, drilling boreholes, fence, fencing and put a fence and a gate.

9. Land/Plot Viewing fees

This is the fee charged when you express interest to go and view a plot of land before purchasing. In most cases some companies charge Ksh 500 or Ksh 1,000 which is nonrefundable.




